

# More Than 60.3 Million Shots Given: Covid-19 Vaccine Tracker

The U.S. has administered 19.8 million doses; Europe's rollout begins

The biggest vaccination campaign in history has begun. More than **63 million doses** in 56 countries have been administered, according to data collected by Bloomberg. The latest rate was roughly **3.21 million doses a day**, on average.

Vaccinations in the U.S. began Dec. 14 with health-care workers, and so far **21.1 million shots** have been given, according to a state-by-state tally by Bloomberg and data from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. In the last week, an average of **1.06 million doses per day** were administered.

### Vaccines Across America

Across the U.S., 6.4 doses have been administered for every 100 people, and 51% of the shots delivered to states have been administered
