The S&P 500 declined 1%, to 4424.11, this past week, with the worst of the drop happening on Wednesday, while the Dow Jones Industrial Average dropped 395.30 points, or 1.11%, to 35,120.08, and the Nasdaq Composite fell 1.3%, to 14,635.81.
