Natural-gas shortages threaten governments' green goals

Yet another crucial global market has gone from glut to shortage at breakneck speed. Last September in Europe it cost €119 (\$139) to buy enough gas to heat the average home for a year and the continent's gasstorage facilities were brimming. Today it costs €738 and stocks are scarce. Even America, which has an abundance of shale gas, has seen prices more than double—albeit from a much lower level—and could see further increases if its winter is a cold one.



The long-term challenge is to smooth out volatility as the switch to renewables continues. Eventually cheap battery storage might solve the intermittency problem; right now, more gas storage would help too. In
