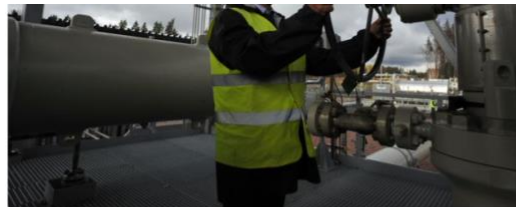

Equities extended their rebound from their mid-June lows at midweek, with the Dow Jones Industrial Average

DJIA -0.43% ▼ gaining a bit over 3% from Tuesday through Thursday, the Nasdaq Composite **COMP -1.87% ▼**

up more than 6%, and the S&P 500 **SPX -0.93% ▼** index roughly splitting

the difference, with a 4%-plus rise. But those gains were pared on Friday amid weak economic news, leaving the major averages up 2% to 3.3% for the week.
