After the bell and at the end of an exciting week for the market, the Dow Jones Industrial Average

DJIA +0.23% ▲ closed 74 points

higher, or up 0.2%. The S&P 500

SPX -0.16% ▼, meanwhile, was down

0.2% at the close, and the tech-heavy

Nasdaq Composite was 0.5% lower.
