Odds of downturn in US now 'almost as likely as the baseline'

Slower consumer spending, more rate hikes among risks

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Federal Reserve staff economists briefed policymakers this month that the chances of a US recession in the next year had risen to almost 50% on risks of slower consumer spending, global economic risks and further interest-rate hikes.

By comparison, economists <u>surveyed</u> <u>u</u> by Bloomberg this month saw a 65% chance of recession in the next year, based on the median estimate. A Bloomberg Economics model puts the probability at 100%.
