Canada and EU Retaliate on Tariffs. Red States Will Suffer the Most.

Canada and the European Union are punching back against President Donald Trump's tariffs, with new levies on American imports tailor-made to cause the most pain to Republican-leaning and swing states.

The European Union on Wednesday announced tariffs on \$28 billion of imports from the U.S., including whiskey, beef, metals, and other products. Canada separately unveiled

additional levies of its own, targeting more than \$20 billion of U.S. imports.
