The stock market has fully recovered from Monday's decline.

The Dow was up 1,100 points, or 2.9%, in Tuesday afternoon trading. The S&P 500 rose 2.9%. The Nasdaq Composite was up 3.2%.

Worries that renewed criticisms of Federal Reserve Chair Jerome Powell by President Donald Trump could lead to a push to oust the Fed chair and upend the central bank's independence sent stocks, long-dated U.S. Treasuries, and the dollar falling on Monday. Things seem to have calmed down, at least for now.
