Today's a Bessent Day and Stocks Are Up

On this note, it was interesting to see Neil Dutta (head of economics research at <u>Renaissance Macro</u> and an *Odd Lots* fave contributor) take a quick look at S&P 500 performance according to which day one of three Trump advisors/cabinet members – Scott Bessent, Howard Lutnick and Peter Navarro – appeared in the news.

Neil finds that since the beginning of March, the S&P has lost a total 719 points on days when Lutnick and Navarro have been the biggest stories. On days where Bessent is in the news, we've seen the S&P 500 go up by a total of 52 points.
